The \$400 million SCI, which will house approximately 4,000 inmates including capital offenders on death row, was constructed using QUIKRETE® Mason Mix Type S Mortar in three colors and QUIKRETE® Core-Fill Grout Fine to lay more than 200,000 square-feet of block. To accommodate the large job site, more than 10 silo systems were strategic placed to deliver the mortar and grout from 3,000 lb. bulk bags in a time and cost efficient manner.
