When construction of the nine story luxury apartments did get underway in February 2012, Roy Rock LLC turned to QUIKRETE® Mason Mix Portland

Lime Type S (PLS) Mortar in 3,000 lb bulk bags applied from multiple silo systems including two five baggers to effectively manage the limited space for staging, mixing and pouring on the jobsite. In addition, multiple mortar colors were required to meet design specifications for laying the block, stone and brick on the Whitehall Towers, which features a three-story underground parking garage, 194 one- and two-bedroom residential units, and a rooftop lobby.
