Our Lady of the Annunciation of Clear Creek is a monastic foundation of the French Abbey Notre Dame de Fontgombault, itself a foundation of Saint Pierre de Solesmes. Solesmes owes most of its fame to Dom Prosper Guéranger, who started Saint Pierre in 1833 in order

to restore Benedictine life in France after its disappearance during the French Revolution. Over the years Solesmes started new monasteries, one of which was the Abbey of Fontgombault, restored to monastic life in 1948. Fontgombault in turn, after having sent monks to three monasteries in France, started one in Hulbert, Oklahoma in 1999 in response to the invitation of His Excellency Edward Slattery, Bishop of Tulsa. The current construction project, the building of the Clear Creek Church which will one day be a cathedral when phases four and five of the project are complete, includes a large amount of QUIKRETE® product. Bulk Products Sales Representative, Carson Wann, reports that the project is using 275 bulk bags of Type S Mortar and 230 bulk bags of Core-Fill Grout - Coarse.
